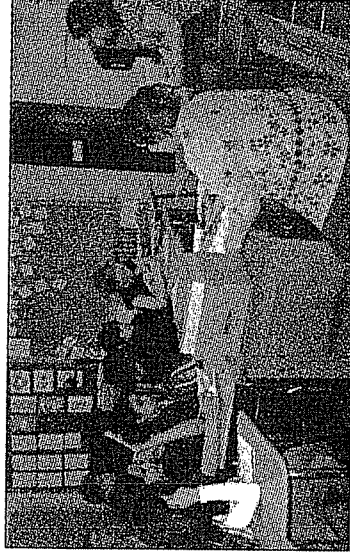


JCCGCI's Horizons Academy and Abraham Lincoln High School Organize Community-Wide SAT Cram Session
